All vendors will be required to have vendor insurance. We have partnered with Duuo Insurance for this. You must sign up through Duuo and proof must be provided when you sign your agreement. If this cannot be provided, we will move on to other vendors.

If you are selling food products, you must have a valid Food Handler's Certificate. This must be submitted at the time you sign your contract.

We will provide lunch from Harry's Hots, along with coffee and tea.
